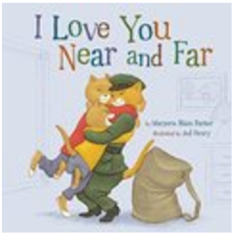


### **Camouflage Mom: A Story About Staying Connected**

*Marjorie Blain Parker*

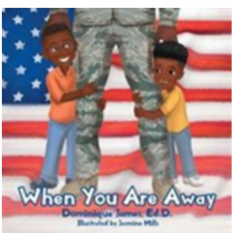
This sweet rhyming story, written from the child's point of view, is a love letter to those who may not be geographically near—but remain very close at heart.
